Removable Seating System: Advanced ergonomic seat design with great adjustment capabilities and all-day comfort. Can be removed for use onshore.

Transport Hold Downs: Friction-lock bungee hold downs keep seat in place during transport, loading, unloading or when you're entering or exiting the kayak.

Adjustment Strap: Single strap for easier seat back angle adjustment.

Multipurpose Dash: 2 deep molded catch-all trays and drink holder.

Bungee Paddle Keepers: Port and starboard paddle keepers with bungees.
